**RESOLUTION NO. 82**

**RESOLUTION DECLARING APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 006, SERIES OF 2019 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BUENAVISTA ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE OPERATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BUENAVISTA AUTHORIZING THE ANNUAL PERFORMANCE BUDGET, FISCAL YEAR 2020 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BUENAVISTA" AS INOPERATIVE IN PART SUBJECT TO SOME CONDITIONS**

WHEREAS, Appropriation Ordinance No. 006, Series of 2019 of the Municipality of Buenavista authorizing its Annual Performance Budget, Fiscal Year 2020 was submitted to this Body for review pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 7160;

WHEREAS, subject Appropriation Ordinance No. 006 has substantially complied with the provisions of the law, except for the Personal Services limitation that has exceeded in the amount of ₱613,650.64, thereby considering the same as inoperative in part as of the date fixed in the Appropriation Ordinance;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Honorable David G. Gano, duly seconded by Honorable Cyril C. Beltran, Honorable Luben G. Vilches, Honorable Josefina G. de la Cruz, Honorable Rex G. Fernandez, and Honorable Karren Kaye A. Gadnanan;

THE 9TH SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN IN SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED:

RESOLVED, to declare Appropriation Ordinance No. 006, Series of 2019 of the Municipality of Buenavista entitled: "*An ordinance providing funds for the operation for Fiscal Year 2020 of the Municipality of Buenavista, authorizing the Annual Performance Budget, Fiscal Year 2020 of the Municipality of Buenavista*" as inoperative in part, effective as of the date fixed in Appropriation Ordinance No. 006, Series of 2019 subject to the posting requirements under Section 59 of R.A. 7160 and subject further to the following conditions:

1. The Internal Revenue Allotment of the Municipality was adjusted pursuant to Local Budget Memorandum (LBM) No. 78 dated May 15, 2019. Considering that FY 2020 Annual Budget of the Municipality has been prepared/approved based on the computed IRA shares under LBM No. 78-A dated December 17, 2019 the Municipality is enjoined to adopt the appropriate measures resulting from adjusted IRA shares, in accordance with pertinent provisions of RA No. 7160 and other budgeting rules and regulations.

2. The amount appropriated for 20% Development Fund shall be adjusted based on the adjusted IRA level. Disbursement shall be in accordance with the Approved AIP in conformity with the provisions of DILG-DBM Joint Circular No. 2017-1 dated February 22, 2017. All projects to be funded shall contribute to the attainment of desirable socio-economic development and environmental management outcomes and shall partake the nature of investment or capital expenditures.
3. The Annual Investment Program (AIP) which constitutes the total resource requirements for all programs, Projects and Activities (PPAs) shall conform to the provisions of Article 410 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 7160. The AIP should be prepared and approved before the start of the local budget preparation phase. Likewise, the local budget shall fund PPAs included in the AIP with Fixed Budget Calendar January 1 to June 15.
4. Disbursement of funds appropriated for the implementation of fifth Tranche salary adjustments shall be in accordance with the provisions of Local Budget Circular No. 121 dated January 24, 2020.
5. The 5% LDRRMF utilization shall be in accordance with Rule 18 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. NO. 10121, COA Circular No. 2012-02 dated September 12, 2012 and NDRRMC-DBM-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2013-1.
6. Intelligence/Confidential Expenses allocation and use shall be in accordance with the guidelines prescribed under COA-DBM-GCD-DND Joint Circular No. 2015-01 dated January 08, 2015. It is understood that the total annual amount appropriated for intelligence or confidential undertakings shall not exceed of the total amount allocated for Peace and Order Program (POP) of the Municipality as approved by the Peace and Order Council.
7. Nutrition Action Plan-DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2018-42 dated March 26, 2018 must be formulated inn the Philippine Plan of Action for Nutrition 2017-2022.
8. The excess in the PS cap shall be strictly observed by the Municipality.

RESOVED FURTHER, to require the Municipality of Buenavista to comply the herein review findings and notify this Honorable Body of the actions taken thereon;

RESOLVED FURTHER, to inform the Municipality of Buenavista that this review action does not authorize any item of appropriation that is specifically prohibited by or inconsistent with the provisions of the law.




