RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING GOVERNOR SAMUEL T. GUMARIN, MD, MPH TO SIGN FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH CENTRI CLINIC LABORATORY

WHEREAS, THE Honorable Governor, in his letter dated June 24, 2019 is requesting for an authority to sign the Memorandum of Agreement with Centri Clinic Laboratory to assist dengue patients of the DCCGNPH;

WHEREAS, as per report of the Provincial Health Office, there is a significant increase of dengue patients at the DCCGNPH and the latter lacks the needed manpower to cater requests for dengue test and other laboratories;

WHEREAS, THIS Honorable Body finds the request to be in order, thus interposing no objection on the same, subject to the terms, conditions and stipulations on the draft Memorandum of Agreement presented before it;

RESOLVED, to authorize Governor Samuel T. Gumarin, MD, MPH to sign for and in behalf of the provincial government, the following:

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

The foregoing Memorandum of Agreement is entered into by and between the Province of Guimaras represented by its Governor, Hon. Samuel T. Gumarin, M.D., M.P.H as the First Party and Centri Clinic Laboratory, a medical institution/laboratory under Philippine domestic laws located at San Miguel, Jordan, Guimaras represented by Dr. Irene Caoyonan, of legal age, Filipino and a resident of Jordan, Guimaras as the Second Party;

WITNESSETH

Whereas, the Provincial Government of this Province has the mandate to protect its constituents and promote health as one of its primary concern;

Whereas, at the present, there is a significant increase of dengue patients in the Province which need to be addressed by the First Party. Attached is the report from Provincial Health Office of this Province as Annex "A";

Whereas, due to the said increase, Dr. Catalino Gallego Nava Provincial Hospital (DCGNPH for brevity) cannot cater all the patients specially the request for laboratories in cases of dengue due to lack of manpower. Attach is a certification from DCGNPH indicating that the laboratory staff lacks manpower to cater all requests for laboratory and dengue tests marked as Annex "B";

Whereas, there is a need to tap the services of private medical laboratories to assist the Province in this situation considering that health issues are not only the concerns of the Province but by all stakeholders including the private sector;

Whereas, the parties agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. The second party will make available their laboratory and services for dengue tests from 4:00 in the morning up 8:00 in the morning to cater indigent patients being referred to by the First party thru DCGNPH in cases where the hospital cannot cater all requests and laboratory procedures in a given time;
2. The first party shall provide a vehicle to fetch the personnel of the second party wherein such personnel such extract blood from the indigent patient at DCGNPH. However, the second party will perform the laboratory services at their clinic. When the results are out, the second party shall communicate with DCGNPH and the latter shall get the results at the clinic of the second party;
3. Only Indigent Patients who cannot afford to pay and have been determined and evaluated by DCGNPH as indigent patients can be catered by this agreement. However, patients who have the capacity to pay can likewise be referred by DCGNPH to the second party but said patient shall be the one to settle their fees with the second party;
4. The second party are entitled to their fees and they shall bill the first party on a weekly basis;
5. The first party upon receiving the bill shall immediately process the payment thereof subject to the usual auditing and accounting rules and payment shall be made 15 days upon receipt of the billing;


6. This agreement shall be for 30 days from execution and may be extended depending upon the health conditions. However, before the 30 day period or whenever the dengue situation is already declared "controlled", the Provincial Health Office shall inform First Party copy furnished to the second party in writing indicating that the situation has been controlled. After which a meeting shall be held by both parties with the PHO to validate the matter and the herein agreement shall immediately be terminated.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution to the Honorable Governor, Centri Clinic Laboratory, for information and appropriate action.
