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RESOLUTION NO. 171

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING GOVERNOR SAMUEL T. GUMARIN, MD, MPH TO SIGN FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH CENTRIHEALTH LABORATORY CO.

WHEREAS, THE Honorable Governor, in his letter dated June 24, 2019 is requesting for an authority to sign the Memorandum of Agreement with Centrihealth Laboratory Co. to assist dengue patients of Buenavista Emergency Hospital;

WHEREAS, as per report of the Provincial Health Office, there is a significant increase of dengue patients at the Buenavista Emergency Hospital and the latter lacks the needed manpower to cater requests for dengue test and other laboratories;

WHEREAS, this Honorable Body finds the request to be in order, thus interposing no objection on the same, subject to the terms, conditions and stipulations on the draft Memorandum of Agreement presented before it;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Josefina G. de la Cruz, duly seconded by Honorable Cyril C. Beltran, Honorable David G. Gano, Honorable Cresente P. Chavez, Jr., Honorable Diosdado G. Gonzaga, Honorable Rex G. Fernandez, Honorable Ma. Sheila G. Gange, Honorable Karren Kaye A. Gadnanan and Honorable Marilou S. Delumpa;

RESOLVED, to authorize Governor Samuel T. Gumarin, MD, MPH to sign for and in behalf of the provincial government, the following:

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

The foregoing Memorandum of Agreement is entered into by and between the Province of Guimaras represented by its Governor, Hon. Samuel T. Gumarin, M.D., M.P.H as the First Party and Centrihealth Laboratory Co., a medical institution/laboratory under Philippine domestic laws located at Buenavista, Guimaras represented by Shella Mae Gustilo, of legal age, Filipino and a resident of Buenavista, Guimaras as the Second Party;

WITNESSETH

Whereas, the Provincial Government of this Province has the mandate to protect its constituents and promote health as one of its primary concern;

Whereas, at the present, there is a significant increase of dengue patients in the Province which need to be addressed by the First Party. Attached is the report from Provincial Health Office of this Province as Annex "A";

Whereas, due to the said increase, Buenavista Emergency Hospital (BEH for brevity) under the Province of Guimaras cannot cater the patients subject for laboratory and dengue tests due to lack of facilities and considering that BEH is an Infirmary. That to refer the indigent patients to DCCGNPH at San Miguel, Jordan, Guimaras is impracticable due to the distance;

Whereas, there is a need to tap the services of private medical laboratories to assist the Province in this situation considering that health issues are not the concerns of the Province only but by all stakeholders including the private sector;

Whereas, the parties agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. The second party will make their laboratory and services 24/7 to cater indigent patients being referred to by the First party thru BEH. Indigent Patients after determination and evaluation by BEH will have to submit their referral slip from BEH duly signed by the latter's authorized personnel to the second party for billing and records purposes. This agreement shall only cover indigent patients who cannot afford to pay the services. However, for those patients who has the capacity to pay, they can likewise be referred but they will be the ones to settle their fees with the second party;
2. The second party shall conduct the laboratory services and shall submit the results immediately thereafter to BEH upon proper coordination;
3. The first party shall provide a vehicle for the patients to be referred to the second party.
4. During daytime, the second party is responsible to deliver the results to BEH. However, from 4 P.M. to 8 A.M., the BEH shall get the results from the second party after the second party has called the attention of the former;

- 5. The second party shall be entitled to their fees and they shall bill the first party on a weekly basis;
- 6. The first party upon receiving the bill shall immediately process the payment thereof subject to the usual auditing and accounting rules and payment shall be made within 15 days from receipt of the billing;
- 7. This agreement shall be for 30 days from execution and may be extended depending upon the health conditions. However, before the 30 day period or whenever the dengue situation is already declared "controlled", the Provincial Health Office shall inform First Party copy furnished to the second party in writing indicating that the situation has been controlled. After which a meeting shall be held by both parties with the PHO to validate the matter and the herein agreement shall immediately be terminated.


Whereas, the parties entered and signed this agreement freely and voluntarily.


RESOLVED FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution to the Honorable Governor, Centrihealth Laboratory Co., Buenavista Emergency Hospital, for information and appropriate action.
